Respect and cooperation between citizens and other nations is essential, as only tolerance among people and a clear vision of joint progress carry value and purpose.

Our common wish is to pay tribute to the memory of Hannah Szenes at this friendship event with gratitude, and to show deep connection and affinity between Slovenian and Israeli people and promote mutual cooperation in the fields of business, culture, science and sport.
